





WHY TRAVEL TO EGYPT?

The ancient Pyramids of Giza and the Step Pyramid at Saqqara. Cairo with its Museum, Citadel of Salah El-Din, Khan El-Khalili Bazaar. The Mediterranean city of Alexandria with the library, Pompeys Pillar, Fort Qaitbey. Balloon ride over Luxor with its Valley of the Kings and Queens, Luxor and Karnak Temples. Cruise along the Nile River or on Lake Nasser. Climb Mt Sinai and visit the Monastery of St Catherine. The temples

in Edfu and Kom Ombo. The resort towns of Sharm el Sheikh and Hurghada along the Red Sea. The Kofta and Sahlab.

CLIMATE

The weather is usually hot in the summer months of April to October with temperatures averaging a high of 33°C, whereas the winter period can be cooler with temperatures averaging a low of 9°C.

CURRENCY

Egyptian Pound (EGP) although US Dollars are widely accepted.

VISA

Australian passport holders require a visa in order to enter Egypt. Visas can be obtained on arrival.

DON'T MISS

The Abu Simbel monuments of Ramses II. You can get there from Aswan by road (a very long drive) or by air (which is what we recommend).

GENERAL:

Q: WHAT IS A WHOLESALER?

A: A wholesaler works with licensed travel agents, rather than direct to the public. Sun Island Tours is an Australian wholesaler, working proudly with Australian agents, to source products in our specialist destinations, including accommodation, tours, packages and cruises.

Q: WHEN WILL I RECEIVE MY DOCUMENTATION

A: Documentation is issued usually 3 weeks prior to departure from Australia.

Q: WHY IS A PACKAGE A DIFFERENT PRICE THAN WHAT WAS INITIALLY QUOTED?

A: All packages are based on certain accommodation. If the accommodation is unavailable to what was initially quoted, then new accommodation with new prices will apply.

Q: ARE DRINKS INCLUDED IN MEALS?

A: Unless otherwise specified, no drinks are included with meals, and are payable on consumption.

Q: DO WE NEED A VISA?

A: For each destination it is best to check with your travel agent to ensure that you get the correct advice based on your nationality and duration of travel. Generally, most of our destinations do not require visas for leisure travel, or can be purchased on arrival in the destination.

TOURS:

Q: WHAT DOES "GUARANTEED DEPARTURES" MEAN?

A: Once you are booked and confirmed on a tour, the tour will definitely go ahead and will not cancel. Minimum numbers do apply though, for instance in Turkey where the minimum number of passengers needed to guarantee a tour is two people.

Q: WHAT DOES "PARTIALLY ESCORTED" MEAN?

A: Partially Escorted usually refers to packages which have portions that are fully escorted, and portions that are independent, or just accommodation with day tours. So with Partially Escorted packages, you would not have access to an escort or tour manager throughout.

Q: I'M A SINGLE TRAVELLER. CAN I SHARE ACCOMMODATION?

A: We do not unfortunately offer any accommodation shares on our tours, cruises or packages.

Q: WHAT IS THE STANDARD OF ACCOMMODATION?

Q: HOW MANY PASSENGERS ARE ON YOUR TOURS?

A: Number of passengers vary depending on the product and destination. We do offer small group tours of less than 20 passengers, however tours can go up to 45 passengers.

Q: WHAT SHOULD I TIP?

A: Usually tipping is extra unless specified on your documentation. Tipping is not mandatory, but we do encourage it if you have received good service. We recommend approximately AU\$ 5-10 per day for guides and AU\$ 3-5 for drivers.

TRANSFERS:

Q: WHAT TIME ARE OUR DEPARTURE TRANSFERS?

A: Departure transfer times will be made available locally up to 48 hours prior to departure.

ISRAEL/JORDAN:

Q: CAN DAY TRIPS BE ORGANISED BETWEEN JORDAN & ISRAEL?

A: Border crossing times are unpredictable and as such we cannot guarantee that you will have enough time to complete the sightseeing in question.

DEPOSIT

A non-refundable deposit of \$200.00 per person is required within 10 days upon confirmation of booking. After this period booking is subject to cancellation. 


